



What is a Drill Rig Operator?

The Drill Rig Operator is responsible for operating track and truck mounted drill rigs installing cast-in-place straight shaft, belled piles and augercast piles for use as foundation support for buildings and other structures. The Operator plans daily installations, reviews construction documentation, evaluates site conditions, anticipates and solves potential installation issues and assures standards of safety and quality are consistently met or exceeded while maintaining the timeline of the project schedule. The job duties include:

- Operate drill rig equipment to complete pre-drill operations for various other types of piling projects
- Operate drill rig equipment for pre-drilling or cast in place concrete piling projects to provide support for buildings and other structures, may be required to operate a variety of other equipment such as skid steers
- Read and interpret construction drawings, pile schedules and pipe tables
- Operate company vehicles and equipment safely, efficiently and according to operating manuals and legal requirements
- Maintain a legal driver's logbook and submit documentation bi-weekly
- Participate in ongoing hazard assessments, daily toolbox meetings and inspections including all required safety documentation and paperwork as per company policy, site requirements and OH&S obligations; report accidents, incidents and near misses
- Provide on the job training and mentoring for construction laborers and junior level equipment operators
- Maintain positive public image of the company with appropriate personal conduct and by operating company vehicles and equipment in a professional and courteous manner

Do you have the following requirements?

- Class 3 Alberta license, clean driver's abstract and own vehicle; must live in or around Edmonton area
- 3+ years of previous work experience operating drilling rig equipment
- CSTS, Fall Protection, H2S Alive, Standard First Aid Level "C", and Ground Disturbance Level 2 certification required
- Ability to complete pre-employment testing, including drug and alcohol testing, a medical questionnaire and a 50 lbs. back assessment
